Financial & General Immigration Requirements and Instructions

Who should submit financial documents?

International applicants who are or will be in F-1 or J-1 visa status are required to show proof of adequate funding for at least one year before an I-20 or DS-2019 form can be issued.

When should you submit your financial documents?

Funding information may be submitted along with the application for admission, or after the admission decision has been made.

What are the requirements?

The minimum requirements for one year are \$30,000 for the Blacksburg campus and \$32,000 for the Northern Virginia Campus. These amounts include tuition and fees, room and board, and miscellaneous expenses. An additional \$4,000 should be added for an accompanying spouse and \$1,500 for each accompanying child. Please note that these amounts are subject to change.

How can you submit financial documents?

Students must submit the Immigration Information Form along with appropriate attachments. The Immigration Information Form follows this page.

What types of documents are accepted?

The following documents are accepted as supporting documents for financial certification (students may have one or a combination of these):

- A current (less than six months old), original bank statement or certification from another legal financial institution, in English. If the statement is not available in English, then an English translation must be attached.
- An Affidavit of Support form (follows this page) OR official letter from the sponsor/bank account holder (if other than the student). The letter should include the beneficiary's name, sponsor's name, his/her relationship to the beneficiary (parent, sister, friend, etc.), the amount of support, the time period for which it will be provided, and a stated willingness to cover the student's expenses for this time period.
- Written confirmation from the sponsoring institution of a scholarship, fellowship, assistantship or other type of funding. In case of an assistantship award from Virginia Tech, a copy of the assistantship agreement signed by the academic department is required.
- In case of personal funds, an original bank statement, or statement from any legal financial institution that includes the student's name, as well as the amount available. If you have only a web statement, you need to write on the bottom of the statement that, "I verify that this is a true copy of my bank statement as of today's date", and sign and date the form.
- Financial documents which are older than six months are not acceptable. Only original, current documents will be accepted.
- Many academic departments do not offer assistantships for the first year of study. Assistantships do not always cover the required minimum funding amounts for immigration purposes.

Other important considerations:

- No international student can work off campus for the first nine months of stay in the United States. Employment on campus is possible, but students should not plan on paying for the complete cost of their education from on-campus part-time jobs.
- We require a copy of your passport before immigration form issuance, so that all documents are issued the same way.
- Your passport should show a Surname or Family name, and a Given name. This should be the name used on the admission application. If there are discrepancies between your admission record, passport, and I-20/DS-2019 form, you will experience problems in the U.S. Please consider updating the passport ID page, or, at a minimum, adding an "endorsement" to the passport that specifies a Surname/Family name and Given name.
- Before leaving your country, confirm that your passport and nonimmigrant visa are valid for entry into the United States. The passport should be valid for at least six months beyond the date of your expected stay.

Deadlines for submission:

The Immigration Information Form and appropriate attachments must be received by the Graduate School no later than June 1st for the Fall semester and no later than November 1st for the Spring semester.
